- Make the researchers aware of the different initiatives that are being carried out in different universities, related to the inclusion of people at risk of social vulnerability.
- Strengthen the cooperation of different research groups and universities, with the aim of generating synergies that favor the implementation of methodologies that favor sustainable social development.
- Identify the different funding opportunities, both in the European, national and/ or regional circuit, with the aim of promoting the development of these investigations, thus achieving a positive impact on improving the quality of life and access to the frame of fundamental rights of people in situation of vulnerability.
- Perform a knowledge transfer and socialization, identifying new protocols and methodological responses that can increase efficiency and effectiveness in achieving objectives in sustainable social development.
- Generate a network of observatories that allows collaborative work between different research groups of different universities, within the scope of social innovation.
- Establish networks with the business and social network that allow a real application of the new research methodologies that are developed within the University.

On the 1st International Workshop on Observatories for Specificity different personalities from different areas will **participate**, such as, the President of the Group of Social Entities CECAP, the President of the Trinjove Foundation and Representatives of the EOI Foundation, the President of the Rural Eurocaja of Castilla La Mancha, the Chairman of the RSC Banco Santander Chair and the Deputy Director of the University Foundation, representatives of Junta de Castilla La Mancha, the Mayor of the Hon. City Council of Toledo, teachers and researchers from the University of Granada and the University of Castilla La Mancha, as well as from the other European and international universities (Portugal, Colombia, Istanbul, among others) and, of course, it will have the participation of the group of people with specificity who are part of the CECAP Social Entities Group, who will show their experience in the performance of the different programs which they are part of.
